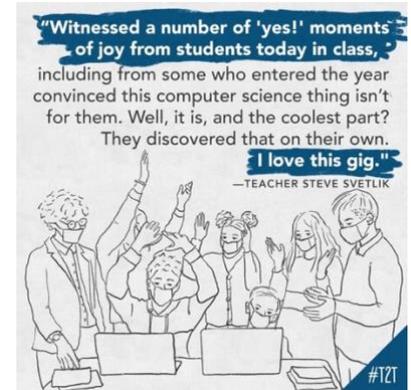

- Engaging new AND veteran K-12 computer science teachers in professional development that includes ongoing, year-long, just-in-time support
- Collaborating with and supporting K-12 school and district administrators on meeting every implementation challenge head-on, as each comes along
- Preparing teachers on-site or virtually, synchronously or asynchronously, for state licensure endorsement examinations
- Supporting school staff in developing inclusive, invigorating, and student-centered curriculum, instruction, and assessment that is aligned to current state standards and that meets the demands of a rapidly evolving technological landscape
- Strategizing with school leadership in planning and/or co-facilitating successful, collaborative, and results-oriented articulation meetings between and across sender schools and high schools that ensure all stakeholders' voices are heard and honored
